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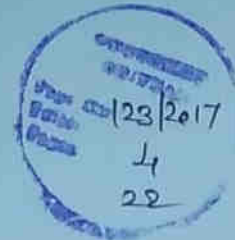

NOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. Name the Trust hereby established shall be named as **"ANNALAR EDUCATIONAL TRUST"**
2. Place : Office of the Trust shall be situate at
No.9, Padmanaba Nagar 5th Street,
Adyar, Chennai - 600 020.



or at such other place in India as the Trustees may from time to time think fit.

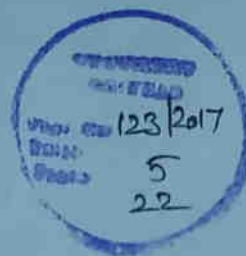
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3. OBJECTS:

The Object of the Trust is to provide and promote education of all types in Engineering, Law, Medicine, Pharmaceutical & Paramedical, Architecture, Arts and Science courses, Schools and especially for the minority and backward communities irrespective of caste, creed, religion or sex without any profit motive whatsoever and more particularly;

- a. To establish, takeover, adopt, support, manage, assist and run Engineering College, Law College, Medical College, Hospital & Research Institute, College for Nursing and Paramedical Science, College of Arts & Science, School of Architecture, Nurseries, Kinder Gardens, Primary Schools, Secondary Schools, Senior Secondary Schools and other branches of education as decided by the Board of Trustees.
- b. To hold lectures, seminars, conferences for the purpose of creating awareness in modern Technical Advancement, Health Care and Medical Fitness in particular and promoting all types of education general and Engineering & Medical Education in particular
- c. To provide financial assistance to deserving students and to award scholarship and/or prizes.



- d. To maintain Hostel, Reading Rooms, Libraries, Research Centres, Cultural Centres, Auditoriums for the Educational and Cultural Institutions run by the Trust.
- e. To promote Indian, Ancient Medical Sciences such as Siddha, Unani, Homeopathy and Ayurvedic throughout the country.
- f. To help and support the poor and the needy particularly in the field of education.
- g. To help Institutions run for disabled, crippled, blind, deaf, mentally retarded and/or otherwise handicapped persons and promote health, characters and vocational pursuits.
- h. To open, establish and maintain orphanages and homes for the poor, children, disabled, stranded women, widows and aged people.
- i. To donate to Government, public and private agencies for famine drought, flood relief and fire victims.
- j. To donate or spend for other objects which are charitable in nature or for public utility within the meaning of the provisions of the Income Tax Act.
- k. To construct, purchase, take on lease or exchange and hold properties, both movable and immovable for and on

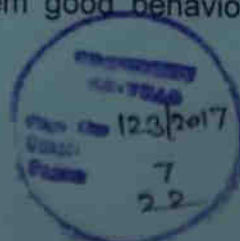


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behalf of the Trust and to use the same for the objects of the Trust and utilize the income therefrom for fulfilling the objects and aims of the Trust.

- l. To sell any movable/immovable property held by the Trust, in the course of carrying on the objects of the trust.
- m. To have rapport with other Institutions, Educational authorities, centres and tie-up Arrangements with their syllabus, the curriculum and accreditation.
- n. To educate students, conduct examinations and qualify them for Certificates and Degrees of Education including IAS, IPS and all other civil services.
- o. To donate or spend on objects which are educational in nature within the meaning of the provisions of the Income Tax Act.
- p. Notwithstanding anything contained in the objects it is open to the Trustees to show special attention for the improvement of status of the people belonging to the Muslim community in the field of education and all steps to uplift of their standard of living and also to learn all the religious matters as stipulated in HOLY QURAN and also the teachings of PROPHET MOHAMED
- q. To impart physical exercises and to improve sports activities among the members of Muslim Community, besides teach them good behaviour hygiene, simplicity





and discipline. To extend financial help to deserving and downtrodden students among the muslim community and encourage them to achieve the high standard and status in the society.

r. To do all other acts and things which are incidental, ancillary or conducive to the fulfillment of any or all the above objects or aims of the Trust and so, however, the objects set out above will be subject to following restrictions.

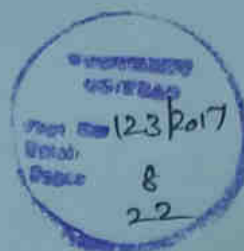
i) The activities of the Trust and its objects will be confined to India.

ii) There will be no profit motive whatsoever and all its activities would be guided, motivated, prompted solely by service motive.

iii) The benefit is intended for the public at large without any discrimination on the basis of caste, creed, language or religion.

iv) The Trust will not embark on any business or activity unrelated to the objects of the Trust.

v) If any of the objects above is found to be inconsistent with the object of public charitable institution exempt under Section 10(23C) or Section 11 of the





Income tax Act, 1961 or any other law applicable to Public Charitable Trust as now enacted or as may be emended from time to time, or any new enactment relating to Public Charitable Trusts, they will be treated as modified to accord with such law.

4. NUMBER OF TRUSTEES: The number of Trustees including the Founder of the Trust shall not be less than 5 and not more than 12 persons. The Board of Trustees shall nominate and invite person / persons to be the other trustees for such period, as they may deem fit and proper.
5. TERM OF OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEES: These Trustees shall hold office for such duration as may be specified by the board of trustees.
6. PRESIDENT : There shall be a president for the administration of this trust, nominated by the board of Trustees, who shall be one amongst trustees as specified in para (4) above for such period, in such manner as may be specified in this behalf.
7. MANAGING TRUSTEE:
 - (i) The day - today administration of the Trust shall be looked after by the Managing Trustee under the guidance, control and supervision of the Board of Trustees.



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(ii) The Board of Trustees shall nominate one amongst the trustees as specified in para (4) above to be the Managing Trustees, who shall hold office for such period, as may be decided by the Board of Trustees.

(iii) The Managing Trustee shall perform all functions, discharge such duties as or specially entrusted to him/her in writing by the Board of Trustees.

8. VACANCIES: Any vacancy among the Members of the Board of Trustees may be filled by the Trustees as specified in para (4) above or their successors and they shall hold office for such duration as may be specified by the Board of Trustees.

9. TERMINATION OF OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEES:

(a) Trustee shall cease to hold office:

(i) if he dies,

(ii) if he resigns,

(iii) if he is adjudged insolvent or found guilty of an offence involving moral turpitude.

(iv) if he is found to have acted against the interest of the Trust.

(v) if it is unanimously decided by the Trustees specified in para (4) above that his continuation in the Office is against the interest of the Trust.

(vi) Upon expiry of the period up to which the Board of trustees have nominated the trustees.



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10. MEETING AND PROCEEDINGS OF THE TRUSTEES: The Trustees shall ordinarily meet once in 3 months or as often as may be necessary for the satisfactory conduct of the affairs of the Trust.
11. NOTICE: 7 days Notice shall ordinarily be given in writing for a meeting of Board of Trustees.
12. QUORUM : The Quorum for the Meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be 3. If there is no quorum for the meeting of the Board of trustees meeting, such meeting shall be adjourned to some other day. If even on that day there is no quorum the trustees who are present at that meeting shall decide the matters that are brought in the said meeting for decision of the board. A minute book shall be kept by the Managing Trustee. Minutes of entry into the office of every new trustee and of all proceedings of the meeting of the board of trustee shall be entered in the minute book and shall be signed by the President of the Meeting.
13. VOTING: Decisions of the Board of Trustees may be made at a meeting or by circulation and decision obtained. The important matters are to be decided and decision obtained. The important matters are to be decided at the meeting. All matters arising for disposal shall be decided by a majority of the Board of Trustees present at the Meeting. The President of the Board of Trustees shall have a casting vote in the event of equality of votes, in addition to his own.



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14. POWERS, FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF THE TRUSTEES:

(a) All property of the Trust Movable or Immovable or of any other kind, shall vest in trust, the trustees shall manage the whole property and affairs of the trust and shall have all powers, duties and functions necessary proper and incidental to the promotion and carrying out of the objects of the Trust.

(b) In particular and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing the trustees shall for the purposes of this trust have the following powers, duties and functions:

(i) To acquire by Gift, Grant, Purchase, Exchange, Lease, or otherwise, lands, buildings, or other immovable properties and also any movable property.

(ii) To construct and maintain buildings, to alter, to demolish or improve them and equip them suitably.

(iii) To accept gifts, donations, endowment and contributions for the Trust and shall be treated as the income of the Trust.

(iv) (a) To raise loans, to receive monies, securities or other movable property on behalf of the Trust.

(b) To accept any trust, trust fund or endowment so long as the provisions of such Trust or endowment are in consonance with the objects of the Trust.



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(v) To award scholarship and make donations calculated to promote the objects of the Trust.

(vi) (a) To enter into contracts, or engagements on behalf of the Trust.

(b) To consider such proposals submitted by Sub-committee appointed by this trust and allocate such funds if necessary as deemed necessary for the implementation of the programmes.

(vii) To make, sign and execute all such documents instruments, as may be necessary or proper for carrying on the management of the properties and affairs of the Trust.

(viii) To invest such monies and such funds of the trust and to vary the investment as and when it may seem necessary or proper provided that such investments shall be made only upon immovable properties or upon securities as the board of trustee may deem fit, under section 20 of the Indian Trust Act, 1882.

(ix) To sell, transfer or otherwise dispose of any immovable property of the trust provided all the trustees unanimously resolve that it is in the interest of the trust to do so to sell or lease, mortgage or otherwise dispose of any movable and immovable properties of the Trust.

(x) To appoint a Committee/Committees of management for such terms and with such powers as may be specified from time to time, for carrying on the routine management of the affairs of the Trust.



(xi) To appoint such employees on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may deem fit for carrying out the work of the trust and exercise control all such employees including the power of suspension, dismissal and removal.

(xii) To delegate to the Managing Trustee or any appointed committee such powers, duties ad functions as are vested in the Trustees.

(xiii) To frame Bye-laws and such other regulations as are required for achieving its objectives.

(xiv) Out of the income of the trust property the trustee shall be entitled to spend or incur the following expenses namely

(a) All rates, taxes, cess, assessments, dues and duties if any payable to the government to any municipal or other public bodies in respect thereof or any part thereof.

(b) The premium for the insurance of the buildings or any other insurable property movable or immovable for the time being forming part of the trust property.

(c) The costs of ordinary repairs and for providing any amenities to the buildings for the time being forming part of the trust property.

(d) The cost of making such additions/alterations or improvements to or in the building forming part of the trust property, as the trustees shall think fit.



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(e) Wages and salaries of any manager, supervisor, accountant, clerk, servant or other employees employed by the trustees in the carrying out of this trust.

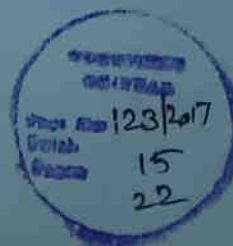
(f) Cost and expenses of keeping the trust property in good condition.

(g) Cost and expenses for installing and renovating the electrical and other installations in the building for the time being forming part of the trust property.

(h) The architect's fee and legal charges and fee payable to other professional engaged in the course of administration of the trust.

(i) All other costs, charges and expenses incidental to the management and administration of the trust property in accordance with the objects and purposes hereof or which may be incidental thereto.

After deducting the costs charges and expenses incurred by the Trustee's as aforesaid out of the total gross income received by them from the trust property the balance that is the net income will be utilized for the objects of the trust as decided by the board of trustees.



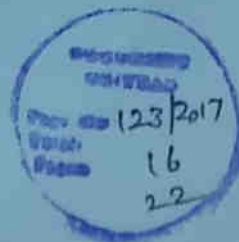
15. BOOKS OF ACCOUNT:

(i) The Board of Trustees may open such Bank Account or Accounts in any of the Banks in the name of ANNALAR EDUCATIONAL TRUST. Such accounts shall be jointly operated by the President and Managing Trustee.

(ii) The trust may open Bank Account/s in the name of institution / organisation founded by the Trust. Such Bank Accounts shall be operated by such persons as authorised by the board of trustees from time to time.

16. APPLICATION OF THE PROPERTIES OF THE TRUST: The properties and funds of the Trust shall be applied only for the purpose of the Trust and for the due administration of its business affairs and properties provided - however that shall not preclude payment of any remuneration or allowance or giving of residential accommodation or any perquisites to any trustee in connection with the work carried out by him / her for the purpose of the Trust.

17. ACCOUNTS: The Trustees shall maintain a true and correct record of the receipts, payments incomes and expenses and transactions of the Trust. The Books of Account of the trust shall be audited by a qualified auditor or a Chartered Accountant every year i.e., commencing from 1st April to the 31st March of next years.



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

18. DEFECTS OF PROCEDURE IMMATERIAL : No act of Trustees shall be invalidated by reason only of any vacancy in the Board of Trustees or any irregularity in the proceedings of the Board of Trustees or any Committee thereof.


19. AMENDMENTS : No amendments to the Trust Deed shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of Section 2 (15), 11, 12 and 13 and 80 G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time

20. DISSOLUTION : In the event of dissolution or winding up of the Trust the assets of the trust remaining in the date of dissolution shall under no circumstance be distributed among the Trustees, but the same shall be transferred to other Trust, Society, Association or Institution whose objects are similar to those of this Trust. At present the trust has no movable or immovable property except the initial fund Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand Only).

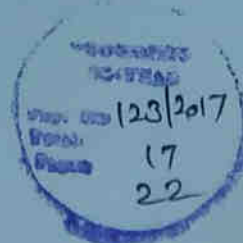

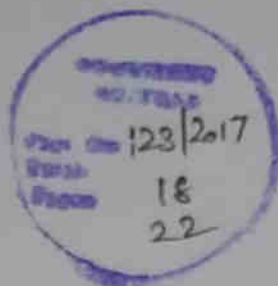

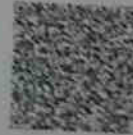
